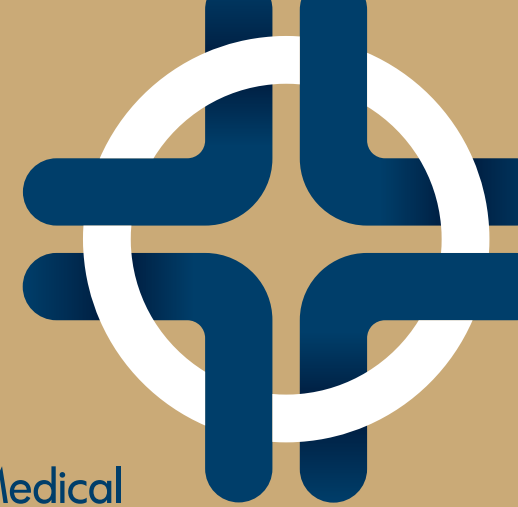
FUNDING ALLOCATION

WELCOME TO CLUB OTAGO



Club Otago is the Otago Medical Research Foundation's renowned corporate lunch series.

Club Otago lunches combine the very best in speakers, community and charity to fund and celebrate high-calibre medical research in Otago.

Four lunches are held each year, featuring the topical speakers of the moment (whatever their area of expertise). They are an excellent event for corporate teams, management, staff and engaging clients.

All funds raised go to the Otago Medical Research Foundation's on-going mission of identifying and nurturing world-class medical research in Otago. Every discovery made has positive implications for each and every one of us.

Individual memberships – \$250 plus GST per annum. This level allows you to purchase your ticket at the special rate of \$65 for all lunch events.

Corporate Memberships are set at three levels:

Senior Fellow - \$5,000 plus GST per annum.
This level allows you four (4) complimentary tickets per lunch (16 in total).

Fellow - \$2,500 plus GST per annum. This level allows you two (2) complimentary tickets per lunch (8 in total).

Associate Fellow - \$1,000 plus GST per annum.
This level allows you one (1) complimentary ticket per lunch (4 in total).

All levels of membership allow additional tickets to be purchased at the cost of \$65 per head.
